#### Nature of support in 2016

*We currently provide:*

- Daily intervention with a team of teaching assistants, working on specific needs and requirements (£8,000 per year)
- Intensive support from a qualified teacher to work on smart targets (£6,000 per year)
- HLTA working on social skills/social and emotional intervention on a daily basis (£3,900 per year)
- Bereavement/Emotional Well-Being Counselling with a trained teaching assistant (£3,120)
- Residential visits and day trips paid for using PPG funding for all PPG children (£1,000 per year)
- Providing Breakfast and After School Subsidy for PPG children if required (as and when)

## Curriculum focus of PPG spending in 2016

*To provide:*

- Support for PPG children in areas of mathematics, including rapid recall and fluency, to enhance their learning
- Phonics programmes developed and delivered to children in all key stages
- Continue the support already provided through intervention in mathematics, literacy and the foundation subjects

## Measuring the impact of PPG spending

*The impact of the PPG is measured every term using the school's PPG provision map. Staff complete individual sheets outlining the provision and the impact that provision has had on attainment and progress of the children.*

*This information is shared at Pupil Progress meetings and at Governors Meetings.*

*The school follows the PPG policy that has been developed and adopted by the SLT and Governors. This feeds in to the PPG provision mapping.*

*PPG children are high on the school's agenda and every effort is made to ensure that the gaps are closing for our PPG children.*
