PSHE:

Geography/ History:

Numeracy:
We will be continuing to develop the fundamental mathematical skills of problem solving, reasoning and fluency, through exploring and 'unpicking' numbers, calculations, fractions, measurement, geometry and statistics.

Science:

Earth and space- the planets
