Science:

This term we will be studying animals including humans in our science lessons.

The children will learn to describe the changes as humans develop to old age. We will also describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans and identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.

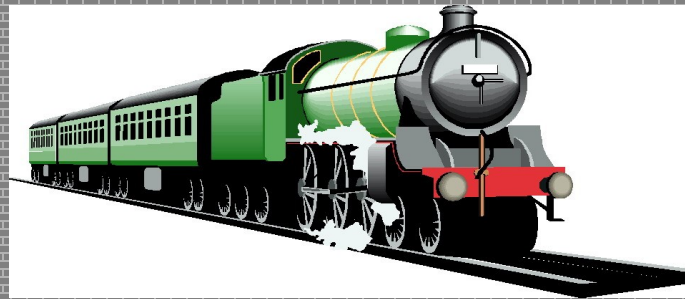
Geography/ History:
