

Returning to School in September

At a glance

- Attendance is now compulsory.
- The children will wash their hands frequently.
- The children will be in class bubbles, they are not required to socially distance within their bubble.
- Bubbles will be kept separate where logistically possible.
- Staff have the option of wearing face masks should they wish.
- Breakfast and After School Club are open from 8am to 5:30pm, usual charges apply. We will be offering a limited menu including: yoghurts, brioche, cereal and dried fruit.
- There will be no other after-school clubs on offer during the Autumn term.
- Teaching time will be prioritised to address any significant gaps in pupils' knowledge. Music is currently suspended.
- Mrs. Morris and other members of the team now have the capacity to support any pupils who are finding the return to school particularly challenging. Please speak to a member of staff if you feel this may apply to your child/children.
- We have a staggered drop off and pick up times of 8:45 – 9:15 and 2:45 – 3:15pm.
- Acorn, Oak and Beech will continue to enter and exit via the staff car park (vehicles will not be moving). Willow and Sycamore will continue to enter and exit via the Pine room at the front.
- We will continue to offer 'grab bags,' not hot meals at this stage. Children may bring their own packed lunch, snacks and drinks.
- Children will return in full school uniform.
- If your child is unwell with Covid symptoms, you will be contacted to collect them and any siblings. They will be moved to the office with an adult whilst they await collection.
