- A forum for you to ask teachers and TAs for support – via Seesaw or email

As parent, we hope you will:

- Provide opportunities for your child/children to access Seesaw on a daily basis
- Upload teaching and learning tasks in the form of photographs, worksheets and/or text
- Communicate with your child's class teacher if you are having any difficulties
- Monitor your child/children's use whilst online
