TRIPS:

Trip to Cosford Air Museum

PSHE: Our key questions to explore are:

What strengths, skills and interests do we have? How do we treat each other with respect?

'PE:

Multiskills work including skills used for basketball and hockey and PE with Mr. Evans from STITC

Geography/ History:

We will be studying World War II, helping children to develop their investigation and evaluation skills; learn to organise information chronologically and understand how past events have helped to shape the world we know today.

We will focus on reasons for the war, which countries were involved, world leaders, the Blitz and homefront, evacuation, rationing, the Battle of Britain and propaganda. We will also look at WW2 in the locality and remembrance day.

Literacy:

Our Literacy this term will be linked with our WW2 topic where possible.

This will include:

World War 2



Music:

This term we will be having lessons from Shrop-shire Music service.

We will also be developing our singing skills through singing WW2 songs, Harvest and Christmas songs.

ART:

We will look at the art of Henry Moore particularly his shelter drawings

DT:

We will be looking at surviving the blitz in air raids, making torches as well as trying out some wartime recipes.

Numeracy:

This term we will be consolidating basic mental maths skills, practising times tables in particular. We will consolidate place value knowledge and move on to developing a written method for addition and subtraction. We will learn about measurement of shapes and apply our knowledge to perimeter and area.

Science:

We will be learning about electricity through making simple circuits, investigating conductors and insulators and making switches. This will be linked to our 'torch-making' in DT. We will also be exploring 'Sound' this term, learning about how sound travels, how sound can be absorbed, pitch, and the inventor Alexander Graham Bell.

ICT:

This will continue to be crosscurricular based, focusing on word processing skills using word and publisher.

We will also develop our computer programming skills using Scratch.

French:

We will develop our French vocabulary through games, songs and role play. We are focusing on words and phrases relating to introductions and greetings, classroom instructions and Christmas stockings.
